COLONEL KEVIN M. MADRIGAL

Colonel Kevin M Madrigal is the Director of Operations for the Air Force Operational Test and Evaluation Center at Kirtland Air Force Base, N.M. He works directly with the offices of the Secretary of Defense and Headquarters U.S. Air Force ensuring realistic, objective and impartial operational testing is conducted on Air Force and joint-use systems. Colonel Madrigal is responsible for the test and evaluation of more than 135 acquisition programs, overseeing the operations of more than 730 members at 12 locations and directly supervising 81 military, civilian, and contracting personnel.

Colonel Madrigal previously served as deputy commander of the 53rd Test Management Group, Eglin Air Force Base, Fla., overseeing Air Force operational test and evaluation program management for Air Combat Command, Air Force Global Strike Command, Air Force Space Command, and worldwide Combatant Commanders. The group's test portfolio included U.S. Air Force fighters, bombers, combat search and rescue platforms, remotely piloted aircraft, aircrew training devices, advanced program networks, space systems and weapons. Colonel Madrigal commanded the 49th Test and Evaluation Squadron, where he directed and executed operational test and evaluation, tactics



development and conventional weapon system evaluation for B-52H aircraft to validate combat readiness of hardware, software and weapons upgrades prior to release to operational units.

His staff assignment includes leading the U.S. Northern Command Special Activities Branch. Colonel Madrigal was the personal military advisor for combatant commanders and staffs on multiple strategic-level programs to facilitate the commander's role of providing direct advice to the President and Secretary of Defense of the United States from fixed and remote operating locations.

Colonel Madrigal's tactical accomplishments include serving as a B-52 instructor weapons system officer, flight examiner, mission commander, and wing weapons officer as well as teaching at the U.S. Air Force Weapons School. Lieutenant Colonel Madrigal has flown more than 600 hours of combat missions in multiple operations.
