Major Jamie U. Cubarrubia is the Director of Communications and Information for Headquarters Air Force Operational Test and Evaluation Center, Kirtland Air Force Base, N.M. As Director, he is responsible for AFOTEC's \$14 million information technology portfolio, supporting six directorates, four detachments, and 10 operating locations covering 14 geographically separated locations across the United States tasked to operationally test and evaluate over 100 major acquisition programs with a combined valued of more than \$1 trillion. Major Cubarrubia directs 30 military, civilian, and contractor personnel responsible for all aspects of communications systems, networks, information management, and information assurance to support the Air Force's Operational Test Agency.

Major Cubarrubia earned his commission through the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps in 2006. Since then, he has served as an expeditionary communications officer at the flight, squadron, group, combatant command, and combat support agency levels. In addition, he has extensive missile warning and intelligence community experience. He also had the honor of serving as the Records Management and Freedom of Information Act Officer for United States Forces in Afghanistan during his 2011 deployment, ensuring family members received a sanitized copy of the final report on the circumstances surrounding the loss of their servicemember, and providing members of the press requested information pertaining to United States military operations in Afghanistan. Prior to his assignment to AFOTEC, he served as an operations officer with the Joint Staff Operations Directorate.
