Lieutenant Colonel Bernadette M. Ramsey is the Director of Communications and Information at Headquarters Air Force Operational Test and Evaluation Center (AFOTEC), Kirtland Air Force Base, New Mexico. As Director, she oversees the modernization of AFOTEC's information technology infrastructure, supporting six directorates and four geographically separated detachments across the United States. This enables operational test and evaluation for major acquisitions. Additionally, she manages a \$20 million portfolio of communications systems, networks, information management, and information assurance, ensuring the full mission capability of AFOTEC's 750 personnel.

Lieutenant Colonel Ramsey was commissioned through the United States Air Force Academy in 2006. She served as a developmental engineer supporting airborne test and evaluation and on-orbit spacecraft engineering before cross-training into cyberspace operations. Lieutenant Colonel Ramsey has led teams at the squadron, group, center, and major command level. Prior to entering the Career Intermission Program, she supported command, control, computers, communications and cyberspace (C5) operations at installations throughout the Indo-Pacific region.
